Instructions for Applicant

- 1. Permit is valid for one year expiring March 31, 2026 or until expiration of insurance coverage as indicated on Certificate of Insurance, whichever is earlier.
- 2. You must include a valid Certificate of Insurance in the amount of a minimum of \$100,000/\$300,000 Personal Injury Liability Coverage and \$100,000 Property Damage Coverage.
- 3. Please include \$5.00 for each single vehicle application, or \$10.00 for a fleet permit. You may pay online here: https://www.mendonvt.gov/payonline/
- 4. Single vehicle permits must be carried in the permitted truck. Although fleet permits are not required to be carried in the trucks, it is advisable to allow quick confirmation of permit by enforcement officers.
- 5. A fleet permit covers ONLY trucks owned or leased by the applicant. It DOES NOT cover trucks owned by independent contractors hired for a particular job. Enforcement officials may ask for proof of ownership or a written lease agreement.
- 6. A fleet permit covers all vehicles bearing the company name. If a permit is to cover unmarked company trucks, attach a list to this form giving year and make of each truck, VIN #, maximum weight and registration number.
- 7. Caution is strongly advised during the times school buses are on the roads. Care should be taken for children in the highway right-of-way. Disregard of this caution will result in the revocation of this permit, at the discretion of the enforcement officer.
